SHERIFF APPEALS TO CITIZENS TO JOIN THE VIRGINIA SHERIFFS' INSTITUTE

In response to the need for improved, widespread public safety awareness and to assist local sheriffs protect the lives and property of citizens throughout Virginia, Washington County Sheriff Fred Newman today announced a campaign that encourages Washington County residents to become Associate Members of the Virginia Sheriffs' Institute (VSI).

Membership appeals will be mailed week of March 1, 2011. Individuals choosing to join the voluntary program can do so for as little as \$20, while businesses can show their support with a \$40 contribution.

The tax-deductible contributions will assist VSI's ability to provide an immediate \$5,000 in-the-line-of-duty death benefit — during the time of greatest need — to the families of Sheriffs or deputies killed serving the Commonwealth.

In addition, VSI provides essential programs to improve the training of law enforcement officers, public safety and crime prevention outreach, and desperately needed scholarships to Virginia students to pursue Criminal Justice degrees.

“Considering the persistent economic crisis and vast budget cuts imposed by Virginia’s General Assembly, our Associate Membership drive has taken on greater importance than ever before,” said Sheriff Newman. “The funding is vital to helping us carry out our mission of making our communities safer places to live, work and play.”
