**Three people have been arrested and approximately \$10,000 worth of stolen property has been recovered as the result of a multi-jurisdictional law enforcement investigation. According to Washington County Sheriff Fred Newman, members of the Washington County Sheriff's Office U. S. Marshal's Fugitive Task Force (CARFTF), U. S. Marshal's Service, Abingdon Police Department and the Bristol Tennessee Police Department participated in the investigation.**

**Christopher Charles Berry, age 24, of 245 Preston Street, Abingdon, VA, was arrested and has been charged with one count of burglary, five counts of grand larceny, four counts of grand larceny with the intent to sell, and four counts of breaking and entering. Berry is currently being held on a \$25,000 secured bond in the Sullivan County Jail.**

**Amy Lorene Arcaro-Moser, age 46, of 245 Preston Street, Abingdon, VA, has been arrested and charged with four counts of breaking and entering, four counts of grand larceny, and three counts of grand larceny with the intent to sell. The accused was released from the Southwest Virginia Regional Jail in Abingdon on a \$7,500 secured bond.**

**Joshua Adam Bailey, age 28, of 25000 Lee Highway, #18, Abingdon, VA, has been arrested and charged with one count of burglary, one count of grand larceny, and one count of grand larceny with the intent to sell. He has been released from the Southwest Virginia Regional Jail on a \$5,000 secured bond.**

**“Stolen property that was recovered include jewelry, televisions, firearms and a log splitter,” stated Sheriff Fred Newman. “This investigation is ongoing and additional charges in regards to other residential break-ins are pending.**

**A court date for Bailey and Moser is scheduled for July 18, 2011, at 1:30 pm in the Washington County General District Court.**

**Berry’s court date is pending extradition from Tennessee. A total of five break-ins were cleared as the result of this investigation.**
