

The Washington County Electoral Board met at 8:40 a.m. on March 7, 2018 in the General Registrar's office. John Lamie and Constance Bundy were in attendance. Derek Lyall, Director of Elections, was also in attendance. James Bebout participated via telephone.


The minutes for the prior meeting were approved.

The next order of business was to elect Electoral Board officers for the upcoming year. The Board unanimously made the following elections:

Mr. Lyall explained that two candidates for Abingdon Town Council, Albert C. "Al" Bradley and James D. "Jim" Moore Jr., filed their candidacy qualification documents simultaneously. §24.2-613(C) of the *Code of Virginia* requires that the Electoral Board draw lots to determine the ballot order in such an occurrence. Ms. Bundy placed a strip of paper containing Mr. Bradley's name into a film canister and a strip of paper containing Mr. Moore's name into a second film canister. The two film canisters were placed into a box and shaken. Mr. Lamie pulled the first film canister from the box and opened it to find the strip of paper containing Mr. Bradley's name. The second canister was removed from the box and it contained the name of Mr. Moore. Therefore, Mr. Bradley will be listed second on the May 1 ballot, and Mr. Moore will be listed third.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at approximately 8:50 a.m.
