

The Washington County Electoral Board met at 10:08 a.m. on November 7, 2018 in Conference Room 2 of the Government Center Building to conduct the canvass of the November 6 election. James Bebout, John Lamie, and Constance Bundy were in attendance. Derek Lyall, Director of Elections, was also in attendance. One provisional voter was in attendance.

The board then went into closed session for consideration of provisional ballots. After coming out of closed session, the Board indicated that there were a total of 15 provisional ballots. The board agreed that three provisional ballots would be counted. A final decision regarding the remaining provisional ballots was postponed until the Board's recessed meeting on November 9, 2018.

At this time, the Electoral Board proceeded with the canvass, and continued until approximately 12:00 p.m. At this time, the Board recessed the meeting to 12:00 p.m. on Friday, November 9, 2018.

The meeting resumed at 12:00 p.m. on November 9, 2018. Mr. Lamie and Ms. Bundy were in attendance along with the Director of Elections. The board conducted a final review of the provisional ballots and then completed the canvass. The board agreed to count a total of 6 provisional ballots and reject 9 provisional ballots.

The Board then certified the Official Results on the abstract of votes that are attached hereto and are incorporated in these minutes. Certified copies of the abstracts were given to the Director of Elections to be forwarded to the State Board of Elections, the clerks of the Towns of Glade Spring and Damascus, and the Clerk of the County.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at approximately 1:00 p.m.
