

The Washington County Electoral Board met at 1:30 p.m. on April 26, 2019 in the General Registrar's office. James Bebout, John Lamie, and Constance Bundy were in attendance. Derek Lyall, Director of Elections, was also in attendance.

The minutes for the prior meeting were approved.

Mr. Lyall reviewed information about the annual State Board of Election Training in Richmond. The training session for general registrars and staff will be on June 24. The training for electoral board members will be on June 25. Mr. Bebout will be attending the electoral board training this year; Mr. Lyall and Regan Carlton will be attending the general registrar training.

The board then reviewed the suggested list of election officials for the June 11, 2019 Republican Party Primary Election. The list was approved after making a few changes.

The board agreed to next meet on June 12, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. to canvass the results of the June 11 primary election. The board will also consider reappointment of the director of elections to a new term at this meeting.

The board then had a general discussion about no-excuse absentee/early voting that will begin with the November 2020 election. The board also briefly discussed the upcoming presidential primary election that will be held on March 3, 2020.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at approximately 2:15 p.m.
