3 **AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 22, ARTICLE II OF THE CODE OF THE COUNTY OF**
4 **WASHINGTON, VIRGINIA, TO REVISE ELECTION DISTRICT BOUNDARIES FOR ELECTION**
5 **DISTRICTS A, E, F, AND G FOR ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AND**
6 **SCHOOL BOARD AND TO REVISE THE GREEN COVE/DAMASCUS VOTING PRECINCT BOUNDARY**
7 **IN ELECTION DISTRICT E**
8

9 **WHEREAS** Article VII, Section 5 of the Virginia Constitution and Section 24.2-304.1 of the
10 1950 Code of Virginia, as amended, (Va. Code) mandate that the governing body of each locality
11 that conducts local elections by district shall on a decennial basis in years ending in “1”
12 reapportion representation among the election districts in order to give, as nearly as is
13 practicable, equal representation on the basis of population;

14 **WHEREAS** Va. Code § 24.2-304.1(C) mandates that the governing body shall use the most
15 recent decennial population figures for the County from the United States Bureau of the Census,
16 as adjusted by the Division of Legislative Services pursuant to Va. Code § 24.2-314 for purposes
17 of decennial reapportionment review;

18 **WHEREAS** the Virginia Division of Legislative Services did not provide such adjusted U.S.
19 Census data to the County until September, 2021, due to delays in U.S. Census collection and
20 processing for the 2020 Census, which caused delay in the County reapportionment process;

21 **WHEREAS** the Washington County Board of Supervisors finds that, based on the adjusted
22 data received from the Virginia Division of Legislative Services, the populations in the election
23 districts as defined in this ordinance give, as nearly as is practicable, equal representation on the
24 basis of population and the election district boundaries described herein comply with all
25 requirements of law; and

26 **WHEREAS** by Order of the United States District Court for the District of Columbia entered
27 on September 23, 2008, the County of Washington, Virginia, and the towns contained therein;
28 being the Towns of Abingdon, Damascus, Glade Spring, and a portion of Saltville; were held,
29 pursuant to Section 4(b) of the Voting Rights Act, 42 U.S.C. § 1973b(b), to be exempt from
30 coverage under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, 42 U.S.C. § 1973(c).

1 **NOW, THEREFORE, ON THE BASIS OF THE FOREGOING,** in accordance with
2 Va. Code §§ 24.2-306 and 15.2-1427 and in consideration of the best interests of the public
3 health, welfare, and safety, and having held a public hearing on this proposed ordinance, the
4 Board of Supervisors of the County of Washington, Virginia hereby ordains the following:

- 5 1. That this ordinance shall be effective immediately in accordance with Va. Code § 24.2-311(B);
6
- 7 2. That the County Attorney, on behalf of the Clerk of the County, is directed to send a certified
8 copy of this ordinance, including a description of the boundaries and a Geographic
9 Information System (GIS) map showing the boundaries of the districts or wards, to the local
10 electoral board, the Secretary of the Commonwealth, the Department of Elections, and the
11 Division of Legislative Services;
12
- 13 3. That the Washington County Director of Elections, in accordance with Va. Code § 24.2-125,
14 *et seq.*, is directed to send a certified copy of this ordinance, including a description of the
15 boundaries and a Geographic Information System (GIS) map showing the boundaries of the
16 election districts and voting precincts, to the Office of the Attorney General of the
17 Commonwealth of Virginia with a request for a Certificate of No Objection;
18
- 19 4. That should any section or provision of this ordinance be decided to be invalid or
20 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the
21 validity or constitutionality of any other section or provision of this ordinance or the
22 Washington County Code; and
23
- 24 5. That Chapter 22 of the Code of the County of Washington, Virginia (2002, as amended) shall
25 be revised as set forth herein, subject to Article, Division, Section, and Subsection titles and
26 numbers amendment by the Editor as necessary for Code consistency. New language is
27 indicated by underline, and deletions are indicated by strikethrough.

10 intersection of Route 677 and Route 58 (Jeb Stuart Hwy); thence north with Route 58
11 to the intersection of Route 58 and U.S. Highway 11 (Lee Hwy); thence west with U.S.
12 Highway 11 and East Main Street to its intersection with N&W train tracks at the East
13 Main St Bridge; thence west with the N&W train tracks to Cummings Street; thence
14 south on Cummings Street to the intersection of Cummings Street and Bradley Street;
15 thence west with Bradley Street to the intersection of Bradley Street and Woolwine
16 Street; thence north on Woolwine Street to the intersection of Woolwine Street and
17 Sutton Street; thence west on Sutton Street to the intersection of Sutton Street and
18 Butt Street; thence north on Butt Street to the intersection of Butt Street and Colonial
19 Road; thence west on Colonial Road to the intersection of Colonial Road and U.S.
20 Highway 11 (West Main Street); thence west on U.S. Highway 11 (West Main Street) to

36 696 (Hillandale Road); thence east with Route 696 to where it intersects Route
37 693 (Litchfield Road); thence south on Route 693 to the intersection of Route 693
38 and Route 779 (Hillandale Road); thence east on Route 779 to the intersection of
39 Route 779 and Route 694 (Northridge Road); thence south with Route 694
40 approximately 1.62 miles to the intersection of Route 694 and Route 609 (Hillman
41 Hwy) at Wimmer's Crossing; thence southwesterly with Route 609 (Hillman Hwy)

1 0.1 mile to the intersection of Route 609 and Route 694 (Stonybrook Road);
2 thence southward with Route 694 to the intersection of Route 694 and U.S.
3 Highway 11 (Lee Hwy); thence west with U.S. Highway 11 to the intersection of
4 ~~U.S. Highway 11 and Route 677 (Watauga Road); thence southwest with Route~~
5 ~~677 to the intersection of Route 677 and Route 58 (Jeb Stuart Hwy); thence north~~
6 ~~with Route 58 to the intersection~~ of Route 58 and U.S. Highway 11 (Lee Hwy);
7 thence west with U.S. Highway 11 and East Main Street to its intersection with N
8 & W train tracks at the East Main Street Bridge; thence west along the N & W train
9 tracks to its intersection with Green Spring Road; thence north along Green Spring
10 Road to its intersection with Blacks Fort Lane; thence along Blacks Fort Lane to its
11 intersection with South Court Street; thence north on South Court Street to the
12 beginning point.

13 The polling place for East Abingdon precinct is Abingdon High School.

14 b. West Abingdon precinct is described as follows:

15 Beginning at a point, the intersection of Route 611 (Spring Creek Road) and U.S.
16 Highway 11 (Lee Hwy); thence north with Route 611 to the intersection of Route
17 611 and Route 883 (Repass Road); thence east with Route 883 approximately 1650
18 feet to the intersection of Route 883 and Milton Drive; thence north with Milton
19 Drive to the intersection of Milton Drive and Route 645 (Wyndale Road); thence
20 east with Route 645 to its intersection with the Abingdon corporation line; thence
21 following the Town of Abingdon corporation line east to a point where it is due
22 north of the intersection of North Court Street and Clark Street; thence south with
23 North Court Street to the intersection of Court Street and East Main Street; thence
24 south with South Court Street to the intersection of South Court Street and Blacks
25 Fort; thence west with Blacks Fort to the intersection of Blacks Fort and Green
26 Springs Road; thence southwest with Green Springs Road to the intersection of
27 Green Springs Road and the N&W train tracks; thence west with the N&W train
28 tracks to Cummings Street; thence south on Cummings Street to the intersection
29 of Cummings Street and Bradley Street; thence west with Bradley Street to the
30 intersection of Bradley Street and Woolwine Street; thence north on Woolwine
31 Street to the intersection of Woolwine Street and Sutton Street; thence west on
32 Sutton Street to the intersection of Sutton Street and Butt Street; thence north on
33 Butt Street to the intersection of Butt Street and Colonial Road; thence west on
34 Colonial Road to the intersection of Colonial Road and U.S. Highway 11 (West Main
35 Street); thence west on U.S. Highway 11 (West Main Street) to the intersection of
36 U.S. Highway 11 and Route 140; thence south on Route 140 until Route 140
37 becomes Route 647 (Old Jonesborough Road); thence southwest on Route 647 to
38 the intersection of Route 647 and Route 611 (Spring Creek Road); thence north
39 with 611 to the point of beginning.

40 The polling place for West Abingdon precinct is Abingdon Elementary School.

2 (1) District boundaries. Election district B- ~~2011~~2021 is described as follows:

3 Beginning at a point on the Washington-Russell County line, the northeast corner of
4 the Tyler magisterial district; thence leaving the Washington-Russell County line and go
5 south with the line approximately 1.2 miles to a point in the centerline of the north fork
6 of the Holston River passing between the properties of M. P. Pendleton and J. Ross
7 Fleenor heirs; thence with the centerline of the north fork of the Holston River,
8 upstream, 1.5 miles to the intersection of Large Creek and the Holston River; thence
9 with Large Creek, upstream, to the intersection of Large Creek and Route 626 (Large
10 Hollow Road); thence southeast with Route 626 approximately 3 miles to the
11 intersection of Route 626 and Route 700 (Rich Valley Road); thence west with Route
12 700 approximately 0.8 mile to the intersection of Route 700 and Route 614 (Mountain
13 Spring Road); thence south with Route 614 approximately 2.0 miles to the intersection
14 of Route 614 and Route 633 (Black Hollow Road); thence east with Route 633
15 approximately 2.2 miles to the intersection of Route 633 and Route 611 (Providence
16 Road); thence south with Route 611 approximately 1.0 miles to the intersection of
17 Route 614 and a stream called Beaver Creek; thence following Beaver Creek to the
18 southwest to its intersection with Route 804 (Rust Hollow Rd); thence east with Route
19 804 to the intersection of Route 804 with the American Electric Power Company power
20 transmission line; thence the American Electric Power Company power transmission
21 line northeast approximately 1.2 miles to its intersection with an unnamed drive north
22 of the intersection of Route 645 and Milton Dr; thence following the unnamed drive
23 south to its intersection with Route 645 (Wyndale Road); thence east along Route 645
24 to its intersection with the Town of Abingdon corporation line; thence following the
25 Town of Abingdon corporation line east to a point where it crosses Route 692 (Whites
26 Mill Road); thence north with Route 692 to its intersection with Route 695 (Chip Ridge
27 Road); thence along Chip Ridge Road to a point where it is crossed by the American
28 Electric Power Company power transmission line; thence the American Electric Power
29 Company power transmission line northeastwardly 2.6 miles to the intersection the
30 American Electric Power Company power transmission line with Route 696 (Hillandale
31 Road); thence east with Route 696 to the intersection of Route 696 and Route 693
32 (Litchfield Road); thence south on Route 693 to the intersection of Route 693 and Route
33 779 (Hillandale Road); thence east on Route 779 to the intersection of Route 779 and
34 Route 694 (Northridge Road); thence south with Route 694 to the top of Walker
35 Mountain at the intersection of Route 694 and Route 740 (Old Saltworks Road); thence
36 with the Walker Mountain ridgeline that follows the drainage divide of Walker
37 Mountain near the intersection of Route 740 and Balsam Drive northeast along the
38 divide to go between the terminus of Route 686 (Moore Creek Road) and Route 737
39 (College Drive) so that the roads of Balsam Drive, College Drive, Tobias Drive, and Tree
40 Top Drive are fully inside this Election District northeasterly 12 miles to a point on the
41 Smyth-Washington County line; thence with the Smyth-Washington County line go

2 being the northeast corner of Washington County; thence with the Russell-Washington

10 the point where Route 80 (Hayters Gap Road) crosses the north fork of the Holston
11 River; thence south, upstream with Fullen Branch in a southeasterly direction to
12 the intersection of Fullen Branch and Route 703 (Chestnut Ridge Road); thence
13 southwest with Route 703 to the intersection of Route 703 and Route 80 (Lindell
14 Road); thence north with Route 80 approximately 0.8 miles to the intersection of
15 Route 80 and Route 703 (Shortsville Road); thence southwest with Route 703 to
16 the intersection of Route 703 and Route 741 (Maiden Creek Road); thence
17 continuing south with Route 703 (Maiden Creek Road) to the intersection of Route
18 703 and Route 740 (Old Saltworks Road); thence southwest with Route 740
19 approximately 0.5 mile to the top of Walker Mountain; thence with the Walker
20 Mountain ridgeline that follows the drainage divide of Walker Mountain near the
21 intersection of Route 740 and Balsam Drive northeast along the divide to go
22 between the terminus of Route 686 (Moore Creek Road) and Route 737 (College
23 Drive) so that the roads of Balsam Drive, College Drive, Tobias Drive, and Tree Top
24 Drive are fully outside this Election District, northeasterly 12 miles to a point on
25 the Smyth-Washington County line; thence with the Smyth-Washington County
26 line go northwest approximately 4.2 miles to beginning point in middle of the
27 north fork of the Holston River.

28 The polling place for Clinchburg precinct is Clinchburg Community Center.

29 b. Greendale precinct is described as follows:

30 Beginning at a point on the Russell-Washington County line, which point is located
31 immediately north of the head of Brumley Creek; thence south to the head of
32 Brumley Creek; thence downstream on Brumley Creek to the point where Brumley
33 Creek crosses Route 689 (Brumley Gap Road); thence leaving Brumley Creek and
34 in a southerly direction crossing Little Mountain at its highest point in this area,
35 crossing Route 611 (North Fork River Road) to a point in the middle of the north
36 fork of the Holston River 1 mile east of the bridge crossing Route 692 (Toole Creek
37 Road); thence upstream along the middle of the north fork of the Holston River to
38 the point where Findley Creek flows into the Holston River; thence leaving the
39 Holston River and following Findley Creek upstream in a southerly direction to
40 Route 700 (Rich Valley Road) and Route 741 (Maiden Creek Road); thence

1 southeast with Route 741 to the intersection of Route 741 and Route 703
2 (Shortsville Road); thence southwest with Route 703 (Maiden Creek Road) to the
3 intersection of Route 703 and Route 740 (Old Saltworks Road); thence southwest
4 with Route 740 approximately 0.5 mile to the top of the Walker Mountain, this
5 being the B-91/A-91 voting district line; thence northwest with Route 694
6 (Northridge Road) to the intersection of Route 694 and Route 779 (Hillandale
7 Road); thence west with Route 779 to the intersection of Route 779 and Route
8 693 (Litchfield Road); thence west with Route 696 (Hillandale Road) to the
9 intersection of Route 696 and the American Electric Power Company transmission
10 line; thence southwest with the American Electric Power Company transmission
11 line 1.5 miles to where it intersects with Route 695 (Chip Ridge Road); thence
12 along Route 695 to the southwest to its intersection with Route 692 (Whites Mill
13 Road); thence south with Route 692 to where it intersects with the Town of
14 Abingdon corporation line; thence following the Town of Abingdon corporation
15 line west 1.3 miles to a point where it intersects a ridge line from the north; thence
16 following this ridge and continuing northward down a valley crossing White
17 Branch then back up a mountain to a point on a ridge top between Route 892
18 (Condor Lane) and Derby Drive; thence following the drainage divide of said
19 mountain in a southwesterly direction to a point where it intersects Route 611
20 (Providence Road) and Beaver Creek; thence north along Route 611 to its
21 intersection with Route 633 (Black Hollow Road); thence west along Route 633 to
22 its intersection with Route 614 (Mountain Spring Road); thence north with Route
23 614 to the intersection of Route 614 and Route 700 (Rich Valley Road); thence east
24 with Route 700 to the intersection of Route 700 and Route 626 (Large Hollow
25 Road); thence north with Route 626 to the intersection of Route 626 and Large
26 Creek; thence north, downstream with Large Creek to where Large Creek
27 intersects with the north fork of the Holston River; thence downstream with the
28 north fork Holston River approximately 1.5 miles to a point, thence 1.2 miles north
29 to a point on the Washington-Russell County line passing between the properties
30 of M. P. Pendleton and J. Ross Fleenor heirs; thence following the Washington-
31 Russell County line east to the point of beginning.

32 The polling place for Greendale precinct is Greendale Elementary School.

33 c. Hayter's Gap precinct is described as follows:

34 Beginning with the north fork of the Holston River at a point where the Holston
35 River crosses the Smyth-Washington County line; thence northwest with the
36 Smyth-Washington County line Russell-Washington County line; thence with the
37 Russell-Washington County line in a southwesterly direction to a point
38 immediately north of the head of Brumley Creek; thence south to the head of
39 Brumley Creek; thence downstream on Brumley Creek to the point where Brumley
40 Creek crosses Route 689 (Brumley Gap Road); thence leaving Brumley Creek and
41 in a southerly direction crossing Little Mountain at its highest point in this area,

1 crossing Route 611 (North Fork River Road) to a point in the middle of the north
2 fork of the Holston River 1 mile east of the bridge crossing Route 692 (Toole Creek
3 Road); thence upstream along the middle of the north fork of the Holston River to
4 the point where Findley Creek flows into the Holston River; thence leaving the
5 Holston River and following Findley Creek upstream in a southerly direction to
6 Route 700 (Rich Valley Road) and Route 741 (Maiden Creek Road); thence
7 southeast with Route 741 to the intersection of Route 741 and Route 703
8 (Shortsville Road); thence northeast with Route 703 to the intersection of Route
9 703 and Route 80 (Lindell Road); thence south with Route 80 0.8 miles to the
10 intersection of Route 80 and Route 703 (Chestnut Ridge Road); thence northeast
11 with Route 703 approximately 0.8 miles to the intersection of Route 703 and
12 Fullen Branch; thence northerly and downstream with Fullen Branch to the
13 intersection of Fullen Branch with the north fork of the Holston River; thence
14 upstream, along the north fork of the Holston River to the Smyth-Washington
15 County line, this point being the point of beginning.

16 The polling place for Hayter's Gap precinct is Hayter's Gap Community Center.

17 d. Woodland Hills precinct is described as follows:

18 Beginning with a point at the intersection of Route 645 (Wyndale Road) and Milton
19 Drive; thence east along Route 645 to its intersection with the Abingdon
20 corporation line; thence following the Abingdon corporation line east to its
21 intersection with Route 19 & 58 (Porterfield Hwy); thence continuing along the
22 Abingdon corporation line for 0.75 miles to a point where it intersects a ridge line
23 from the north; thence following this ridge and continuing northward down a
24 valley crossing White Branch then back up a mountain to a point on a ridge top
25 between Route 892 (Condor Lane) and Derby Drive; thence following the drainage
26 divide of said mountain in a southwesterly direction to a point where it intersects
27 Route 611 (Providence Road) and Beaver Creek; thence north along Route 611 to
28 its intersection with Route 633 (Black Hollow Road); thence west along Route 633
29 to its intersection with Route 611 (Providence Road) and Beaver Creek; thence
30 following Beaver Creek to the southwest to its intersection with Route 804 (Rust
31 Hollow Road); thence east with Route 804 to the intersection of Route 804 with
32 the American Electric Power Company power transmission line; thence with the
33 American Electric Power Company power transmission line northeast
34 approximately 1.2 miles to its intersection with an unnamed drive north of the
35 intersection of Route 645 and Milton Drive; thence following the unnamed drive
36 south to its intersection with Route 645 (Wyndale Road), this being the point of
37 beginning.

2 (a) Central absentee voter precinct. There is hereby established for the county in the
3 Government Center Building at 1 Government Center Place, in Abingdon, Virginia, a central
4 absentee voter precinct, which precinct shall be used for all elections held in the county
5 including the municipal elections held in the various towns located within the county and
6 primary elections. Such precinct shall be established and operated in accordance with Code
7 of Virginia, § 24.2-700 et seq.

8 (b) Satellite voter location. There is hereby established for the county in the Southwest Virginia
9 Higher Education Center in Abingdon, Virginia, a voter satellite office, which may be used
10 for absentee voting in person in advance of all elections held in the county including the
11 municipal elections held in the various towns located within the county and primary
12 elections in accordance with Code of Virginia, §§ 24.2-701.1 and -701.2, as amended from
13 time to time. Such location shall be deemed the equivalent of the office of the general
14 registrar for the purposes of completing the application for an absentee ballot in person
15 pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 24.2-701 and 24.2-706. Not later than 55 days prior to any
16 election, the general registrar shall post notice of all voter satellite office locations in the
17 county and the dates and hours of operation of each location in the office of the general
18 registrar and on the official website for the county for the duration of the period during
19 which absentee voting in person is available.
