### Civic Participation:

- Elected to the Glade Spring Town Council and served from 1996 to 2008 and again from 2019 to 2024.
- I am a Washington County native and have lived in Glade Spring for 57 years. I attended Patrick Henry High School (1981) and VHCC with a degree in Drafting & Design in 1984. Then attended UNC Charlotte and Central Piedmont Community College, taking several other engineering courses.
- Volunteered as the Washington Chapel youth ministry leader for 25 years and served as a Washington County Young Life youth leader and committee member.
- I have been part of the Patrick Henry FCA Adult Leadership committee
- On the Town Council, I served as the Vice Mayor, Acting Mayor, and as several committee chairmen.
- I helped develop events to celebrate the town's 150-year celebration in 2025 as the chairman of the event committee.
- Named and received recognition as the Citizen of the Year in December of 2025.
- Helped create the PH Graduate's Parade event during the pandemic in 2020.
- Created the Rising Star's Showcase event, highlighting the area's young talent and giving them a stage to share and shine.
- Nominated by Wayne Stevens to serve as a board member of the Washington County Park Authority in the late summer of 2025. Then was elected by the Board and began serving in August of 2025.

Work Responsibilities:

- Working at Utility Trailer, I was part of the safety safari team that looked at all aspects of safety in the plant. As a part of this team, we went through the plant in each department.
